ADMINISTRATIVE COMPLAINT

The Michigan Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs (Complainant) by Kim Gaedeke, Director, Bureau of Professional Licensing, files this Complaint against Abolarin Agbona, D.V.M. (Respondent) as follows:

1. The Michigan Board of Veterinary Medicine (Board) is an administrative agency established by the Public Health Code, MCL 333.1101 et seq. Pursuant to section 16226 of the Public Health Code, supra, the Board's Disciplinary Subcommittee is empowered to discipline licensees for violations of the Public Health Code.

2. Respondent is licensed as a veterinarian in the state of Michigan and has a controlled substance license.

3. On June 25, 2015, the Board's Disciplinary Subcommittee executed a Consent Order and Stipulation (Order) that placed Respondent on probation for a minimum of one day and not to exceed one year. The terms of probation, in part, required Respondent to complete five hours of continuing education in each of the following areas

by July 25, 2016: a) aseptic technique, b) controlled substances, and c) acute abdomen surgical technique. A copy of the Order, marked Exhibit A, is attached and incorporated.

4. Contrary to the terms of the Order, Respondent failed to complete the required continuing education by July 25, 2016.

COUNT 1

Respondent's conduct, as set forth above, evidences a violation of a final order issued by the Board's Disciplinary Subcommittee, contrary to Mich Admin Code, R 338.1632, in violation of section 16221(h) of the Public Health Code, supra.


Complainant requests that this Complaint be served upon Respondent and that Respondent be offered an opportunity to show compliance with all lawful requirements for retention of the license. If compliance is not shown, Complainant further requests that formal proceedings be commenced pursuant to the Public Health Code, rules promulgated thereunder, and the Administrative Procedures Act, MCL 24.201 et seq.

Pursuant to section 16231(8) of the Public Health Code, supra, Respondent has 30 days from the date of receipt of this Complaint to submit a written response to the allegations contained herein. The written response shall be submitted to Complainant, Kim Gaedeke, Director, Bureau of Professional Licensing, Department of Licensing and Regulatory Affairs, P.O. Box 30670, Lansing, MI 48909.

Pursuant to section 16231(9) of the Public Health Code, supra, Respondent's failure to submit a written response within 30 days, as noted above, shall be treated as an admission of the allegations contained herein and shall result in transmittal of this Complaint directly to the Board's Disciplinary Subcommittee for imposition of an appropriate sanction.
